That the Board:

- e Board: Approve the proposed Concession Agreement, between the City of Los Angeles and John discontion 1. Wells Golf Shops, Inc., for a period of twelve (12) months, substantially in the form on file in the Board Office, subject to approval of the Mayor, the City Attorney as to form, and the United States Army Corp of Engineers, as required by the Hansen Dam Flood Control Basin Lease No. DACW09-1-67-11;

Direct the Board Secretary to transmit the proposed Concession Agreement, concurrently, to the Mayor, in accordance with Executive Directive No. 3, the City Attorney, for approval as to form, and Army Corps of Engineers, as required by the Hansen Dam Flood Control Basin Lease No. DACW09-1-67-11; and,
- 5. Authorize the Board President and Secretary to execute the Concession Agreement upon receipt of the necessary approvals.

## SUMMARY:

The Hansen Dam Golf Course is located at 10400 Glenoaks Boulevard, Pacoima, CA 91331 and includes one 18-hole golf course operated and maintained by the Department. The Hansen Dam Golf Course Professional Concession (Concession) provides professional golf lessons to patrons, and maintains and operates the golf professional shop and the golf driving range.

The Hansen Dam Golf Professional Concession is currently operated by John Wells Golf Shops, Inc., under Concession Agreement Number 233 which was executed on October 1, 1997, for a term of ten years and has been operated on a month-to-month basis since the agreement expired on September 30, 2007. In calendar year 2007, the Concession generated \$671,783 in gross receipts and paid \$85,575 in rent to the City.

On January 31, 2008, the operator, John Wells, submitted a notice to quit the concession citing reduced play at the golf course due to construction and the decline in the golf industry. Staff began discussions with the operator and requested bids from other golf professionals. With consideration of a new operator having to provide equipment and assuming the maintenance of the pro shop and driving range, the transition to a new operator while construction at the golf course continues and while a formal RFP process is underway is not advantageous to the City at this time.

During the term of this agreement the operator will pay a percentage of the gross revenue as rent to the City: Professional Shop -3% (previously 7%); Lessons -5% (previously 7%); and, Driving Range -20% (previously 35%).

This agreement will discontinue the living wage adjustment that the operator was allowed to deduct from rent payments and discontinue the monthly capital improvement contribution made by the operator.

It is recommended that a short-term Concession Agreement be approved until a formal Request for Proposal (RFP) process is completed and a multi-year concession agreement may be executed. While there will be a reduction in rent payment to the City, the agreement will ensure that the level of service is continued to the public and any revenue shortfall is minimized.

Charter Section 1022

Los Angeles City Charter Section 1022 prohibits contracting out work that could be done by City employees unless the Board determines it is more economical and/or feasible to contract out the service.

On May 15, 2008, the Personnel Department completed a Charter Section 1022 review (Attachment A) and determined that the City classification of Park Service Attendant could perform some of the work, primarily the maintenance of the driving range. The Personnel Department also found that City employees do not have the expertise to manage a Professional Golf Shop, nor are there City classifications that require a PGA Class "A" certificate in order to provide professional golf lessons. It is therefore more feasible to contract out the service.

On December 11, 2008, the Board approved the release of a Request for Proposal (Board Report No. 08-328) for this concession. The RFP process is expected to take up to twelve months to complete. This agreement will be subject to earlier termination upon the execution of a multi-year concession agreement.

# FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT:

It is estimated that during the twelve month term of the concession agreement, approximately \$59,149 will be paid in rent to the Department. Of that amount, approximately \$53,234 will be deposited in the Department's General Fund and approximately \$5,915 will be deposited into the Golf Concession Improvements Account.
