RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board:

- 1. Approve the proposed changes to the Schedule of Rates and Fees for Tregnan Golf Academy as outlined in the body of this report; and,
- 2. Authorize staff to make the changes in the Department's Rates and Fees Manual effective June 1, 2009.

SUMMARY:

Tregnan Golf Academy's ("Tregnan") mission is to introduce the game of golf to youth and provide them with the skills, knowledge, and confidence to play the game throughout their lives. The focus of the academy is to reach out to young people from urban areas that have little or no exposure to the game of golf by making Tregnan accessible, affordable, and enjoyable. Tregnan is fully operated and maintained by the Department.

The cost of operating the Tregnan Golf Academy has increased tremendously over the last several years due to rising energy, labor, and material costs. As a result, the Department is proposing to raise fees to offset some of the increase in costs and continue to be able to offer an excellent recreation and educational golf program for youth. To help reach this goal, the Department is proposing increasing class fees by \$10 per session. For example, the 10 week class fee for Tiny Tots, Little Linkster, and Pro Linkster classes will increase from \$50 per session to \$60 per session; Junior Tour and Open Enrollment fees will increase from \$75 to \$85

per session; Family Golf fees will increase from \$60 to \$70 per session; and fees for youth transported in from various recreation centers will increase from \$35 to \$40 per session. See Attachment A, for the complete list of fee changes. Attachment A also includes fees that had not been previously incorporated into the Rates & Fees Manual, however, the fees have not changed.

A comparison of local junior golf programs shows that Tregnan fees are extremely competitive. For example, with this fee increase, the hourly instruction rate for Tregnan's Junior Tour program is \$5.66. The junior instruction rates at other local golf facilities average to over \$10.00 per hour.

It is estimated that the Tregnan class fee increase will generate additional revenues of \$10,000 per year, which will be deposited into the Department's Fund 301, Department 88, Account 013M. Funds from this account are entirely utilized to pay for golf instruction employees and material costs.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT:

There is no impact to Department's General Fund, as all additional fees collected will be deposited into Fund 301, Department 88, Account 013M, and expenses will be paid out of this account.
