RECOMMENDATION

Approve the installation of recognition signage in appreciation of the gift contributions from the Los Angeles Dodgers Foundation and their partner-donors, consisting of Dreamfield ballfield improvements at Gilbert Lindsay Recreation Center, as illustrated by the signage rendering(s) included with this Report as Attachment 1.

SUMMARY

The Los Angeles Dodgers Foundation (LADF) together with their partner-donors (collectively "Donors"), funded the development of "Dreamfield" ballfield improvements valued up to Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00), at Gilbert Lindsay Recreation Center located at 429 East 42nd Place, Los Angeles, CA 90011 (Project). The Project's scope of work consisted of various field improvements such as, but not limited to, soil and turf treatment, grading, soil amendments and compaction, irrigation, sod installation, infield mix, batter's box and pitching area clay, infield fixtures and conditioner, backstop padding, dugouts, bleachers, drive gates, and drinking fountain.

With the exception of certain recognition panels included on LADF's proposed recognition signage which did not identify specific donors and contained "Potential Donor" as a place-holder for the future, the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners (Board) approved the Project and related Gift Agreement for the improvements (Agreement) on February 6, 2020 (Report No. 20-028), and accepted the Project subject to its completion (Field) with the understanding that

Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) staff would return to the Board for approval of the final recognition signage once provided by the LADF containing all the confirmed project Donors. The field dedication occurred in early July 2020.

Included in the Agreement were preliminary renderings of the proposed scoreboard design and recognition signage to be displayed at the Field, including backstop signage and an outfield fence windscreen, recognizing the in-kind and monetary contributions provided by the Donors, in accordance with RAP's Sponsorship Recognition Policy. The preliminary recognition signage design contemplated the possible inclusion of additional sponsors, which LADF would identify at a later date. LADF recently submitted renderings of the revised recognition signage which includes the names of the additional Donors for approval by the Board to replace the preliminary designs previously included in the previous Report No. 20-028 and Agreement.

LADF additional sponsors identified for the proposed recognition signage include:

- The Los Angeles Dodgers Foundation;
- The 2020 Major League Baseball World Series Champion Los Angeles Dodgers;
- LA84 Foundation, a long-standing supporter of RAP;
- Kershaw's Challenge, a nonprofit organization focused on community improvement and social good; and,
- Major League Baseball.

RAP staff recommends that the Board approve the proposed final renderings of the recognition signage (Attachment 1). The proposed recognition signage will replace any currently existing sponsor recognition signage at the baseball field.

FISCAL IMPACT

Approval of the recognition signage will have no negative effect on RAP's General Fund as LADF will fund the fabrication and installation of such signage.




