RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Accept a donation from Los Angeles Parks Foundation (LAPF) valued at Thirteen Thousand Dollars, Six Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars and Thirty-Two cents (\$13,622.32) for four pieces of calisthenics equipment and their installation at Venice Beach Recreation Center.

SUMMARY

Venice Beach Recreation Center (Venice RC) is a world famous location that offers a variety of open amenities to the public. The open calisthenics area has a variety of equipment pieces such as parallel bars, Olympic rings, climbing ropes and many more. Due to the harsh climate near the beach many of these pieces of equipment have started to rust and break.

The Los Angeles Parks Foundation (LAPF) purchased calisthenic equipment valued in the amount of \$5,482.32 from Kenguru Professional, a vendor of calisthenic equipment and donated that equipment to RAP for use at Venice RC. In addition, LAPF donated an additional \$8,140.00 in funds by paying for the removal of damaged equipment and installation of the donated calisthenic equipment by RAP's vendor, Child's Play. The donation form, equipment invoice, installation invoice and pictures of the installed donated equipment are attached to this Report as Attachments 1, 2, 3 and 4 respectively.

The donated calisthenic equipment which was installed at the Venice RC open calisthenic area are the following:

- (1) Column 2100mm
- (1) Column 2600mm
- (3) Column 3300mm

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- (1) Crossbar 1758mm
- (1) Swedish wall
- (12) Blue brackets

Venice Beach has over 10,000 visitors daily and many people in the calisthenics community were pleased to see some much-needed improvements to this area. The equipment was officially installed on Monday, May 16th, 2022. The installation company was able to remove the existing three chin bar system that was rusted and broken as well as all debris from the area.

FISCAL IMPACT

The installation of new calisthenics equipment as set forth in this Report had no fiscal impact on RAP's General Fund as all costs of materials and installation were funded by The Los Angeles Parks Foundation donation.
